



## ***Fox Valley WI H.O.G Chapter - Alcohol Policy***

*This adopted policy is in keeping with National H.O.G. Insurance Risk Assessment and with National H.O.G. Alcohol Guidelines and is for the safety and protection of all Fox Valley WI H.O.G. Chapter members and guests.*

### **All Fox Valley Wisconsin H.O.G. Chapter riding events are alcohol free.**

*Safe and responsible motorcycling is a major H.O.G. goal. The consumption and use of alcohol is a serious personal responsibility involving the safety and welfare of family, riding friends and the individual H.O.G. member. Any amount of alcohol negatively affects a rider's ability to operate a motorcycle.*

***Therefore, it is the policy of the Fox Valley Wisconsin H.O.G. Chapter that the chapter will not furnish alcohol at events and the consumption of alcohol is strictly prohibited prior to and during chapter riding events. Anyone consuming alcohol before or during a riding event will be asked to leave the event. If the person consuming alcohol refuses to leave the ride then the leader of the ride will declare that the riding event is over.***

*At the point where the motorcycling activity is deemed CONCLUDED, and the kickstands drop at the last stop, members and participants should use good judgment and responsibility to determine the level of alcohol use, if any, that is appropriate and safe.*
