The ASM *Advanced Bystander Assistance* course is offered to students that have previously completed the *Basic Crash Course for the Motorcyclist* and whose certification is still current (*Basic Class, Blended Learning Class or Refresher Course* completed within the last two years).

This Course includes a combination of presentations, discussions, demonstrations and hands-on learning. It takes your training to the next level of emergency response so that you can better prepare for and more confidently assist the professional Emergency Responders when they arrive.

Topics include:

- Chain of Survival and different levels of EMS response
- Assessing, opening and maintaining an injured persons airway
- Identifying and responding to common medical emergencies
- Treating serious leg fractures
- Performing a complete patient head-to-toe assessment
- Taking the lead and assigning roles to other bystanders until EMS responders arrive
- Managing the stress of dealing with a traumatic situation

Cost is \$85.00 and includes an instruction book and the class room training. Upon completion students receive a certification and “*Advanced*” rocker patch to position over their Road Guardian ASM patch. For EMS and medical professionals this class provides 6.0 CEU’s.
