A Crash Course for the Motorcyclist

As motorcyclists we often ride with others and in groups and another motorcyclist is often the first on the scene of a motorcycle accident. And emergency response studies show that the care a person receives in the first minutes after an injury has a direct impact on patient outcomes. If you're on the scene of a motorcycle crash do you know how to respond?

This intensive course includes a blend of on-line learning followed by class room instruction that includes presentations, open discussions, and hands-on skills learning and practice. You'll come away with the knowledge, skills and confidence to react swiftly and appropriately should the need ever arise. Although this course is focused towards the motorcyclist the skills learned are applicable to any trauma situation.

Students register for the on-line portion prior to the hands-on class and have 30 days from registration to complete the on-line instruction. Cost is \$35.00 and includes a downloadable text book and completion certificate (bring with you to the classroom training). The classroom portion of the class will be conducted in the Appleton Harley Davidson Training Center (see above). You will receive instruction on and practice: moving the injured and/or the cycle; when & how to safely remove a helmet; how to perform rescue breathing; assessing the injured; bleeding control; splinting; shock recognition & treatment; spinal immobilization; and more. Students who have previously completed the Basic Course and whose certification is still current can register for and attend this hands-on course to renew their certification.

Upon completion of both the on-line and class room instructions each student receives a certificate of completion and embroidered ASM patch. Certification is valid for two-years and can be renewed by attending another hands-on portion of a blended learning class or taking a Refresher Course. This course provides 6.0 CEU's for EMS and Medical professionals.

The *Advanced Learning Course* will be conducted the following day (Sun. 11/17/19) and is available to students completing this blended course, or students already possessing the *Basic Crash Course* certification.
